Day 1: Saturday 5 September 2015 Arrive Prague 🖫 💹

In the morning we arrive in Dürnstein, one of the most enchanting villages of the Wachau wine region. Thereafter you drive through the picturesque landscape of this district to the 900– year old Benedictine Abbey of Melk, which features Austria's finest Italian baroque architecture.

Day 9: Sunday 13 September 2015

Passau 🔯

Cruise along the Danube this morning, in the afternoon we reach Passau. Cobblestone streets and graceful arcades welcome you in this beautiful city. On this afternoon's walking tour, stroll through the old town's narrow alleys and see the hilltop Oberhaus Fortress from the town below. Visit St. Stephen's Cathedral, a wonderful example of Baroque architecture and home to Europe's largest church organ with more than 17,000 pipes.

Day 14: Friday 18 September 2015 Miltenberg (FB,L,D)

Travel to the picturesque village of Miltenberg on the Main River. The village is lined with well–preserved half–timbered buildings. The gothic Merchant Hall is an impressive symbol of past affluence created by trade from river traffic. Upon returning to the ship, discover the methods of traditional glassblowing in a private demonstration on board.

Day 15: Saturday 19 September 2015

Rüdesheim – Koblenz 🔯

After breakfast we arrive at Rüdesheim, one of Germany's most popular towns. Join the "Winzer-express" minitrain ride to Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum. Today's cruising will be a highlight of your trip, as we cruise through the spectacular Rhine Gorge. In the late afternoon we cruise to the beautiful 2,000 year old town of Koblenz situated at the confluence of the Moselle River.


